



Coaches Rotation List Criteria Roles and Responsibilities

1. Must be an active registered NCCP Level II coach with Boxing Alberta. Must be at least NCCP Level III for International team travel or Canada Winter Games.
2. Must have attended at least two (2) of the major tournaments in the previous competition season.
3. Must have a valid police security check submitted to the Alberta Boxing office one (1) month prior to traveling with an Alberta Provincial Team. Security check will be valid for a two (2) year period.
4. If a coach declines a trip their name goes to the bottom of the Coaches Rotation List.
5. If a coach accepts a trip they must attend the training camp and their name will be drop to the bottom of the Coaches Rotation List after the trip.
6. Any International trip must have at least one (1) coach with previous international experience and minimum NCCP Level III.
7. For National Championships, the coach with the most athletes on the team will qualify and the second (2nd) coach will come from the Coaches Rotation List, both coaches must ne a minimum NCCP Level II.
8. If a female athlete travels with the Alberta Provincial Team outside of Alberta, the Boxing Alberta Board of Directors may, in its discretion, appoint a female coach or chaperone to accompany the team.
9. Coaches must follow the rules of Boxing Alberta and make the athlete's well being their priority.
10. Coaches must be fully involved with the athletes while on the trip.
ie: Supervision, meals, curfews, training, warm-ups and competitions. Work as a TEAM.
11. All coaches may be subject to reviews by the Boxing Alberta Board of Directors, and may be suspended from the Coaches Rotation List due to circumstance and performance.
